Principal's Message

Dear Loyola Families,

New Bike Rack Location

We are adding a bike rack to the lower playground. We are currently evaluating the safety of students and pedestrians coming to and from school. One safety issue has been the pedestrian and bike traffic that crosses the three driveways in front of the parking lot. Often cars exiting and entering the parking lot and circular drive have difficulty seeing pedestrians and bicyclists moving south on Berry. Beginning today we will have a bike rack placed in front of the tetherball court on the lower playground. Any bike riders coming to school from Springer/Magdalena heading south on Berry, we ask you to enter campus at the sidewalk before the circular drive and walk bike to lower playground and park bike at bike rack in front of the tetherball court. If you are coming north on Berry from Miramonte please continue to park your bike in the bike cage. Another safety measure we are exploring is making parking off limits in front of the parking lot. We currently are looking at placing a red curb along the parking lot on Berry Avenue to increase visibility as cars exit the parking lot and the circular drive. We will let you know when this happens.
